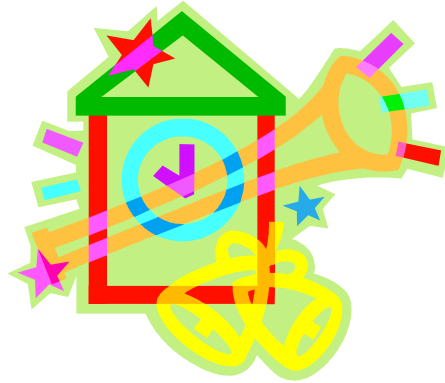

CR Report: It's snowing outside so shovel the snow off the roses and get them covered with soil. You should have your roses covered and a dormant spray put on them. With bigger roses take stakes and tie them back with twine to make sure they don't break off in the winter. Make sure and MOUND UP THE SOIL!! About a foot and a half is what would be good. Dormant Spray will help them go dormant and keep the pests and bugs at bay. Some insects can over winter with your roses and the dormant spray has chemicals in them to kill the pests that can over winter. Make sure and wear LONG CLOTHING when you apply Dormant Spray or any kind of oils.

New Business: Jackie and Clint are going to get a hold of Matt from Abele to see if they would donate a few Knockout roses to plant along the side of the meeting room where we meet to help draw people into the room. The zoo will have the information available at the end of February. Up on the front table are chemicals that the society is selling at HALF PRICE. In February we will have more chemicals here.

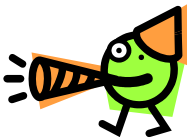
