New Business: Next month (July) is the garden crawl. We are starting at Nancy S. going from there to Madeline M. to Howards and then ending at Crystal Kauer's house.

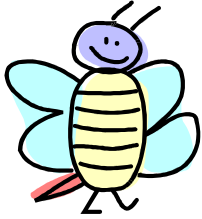
