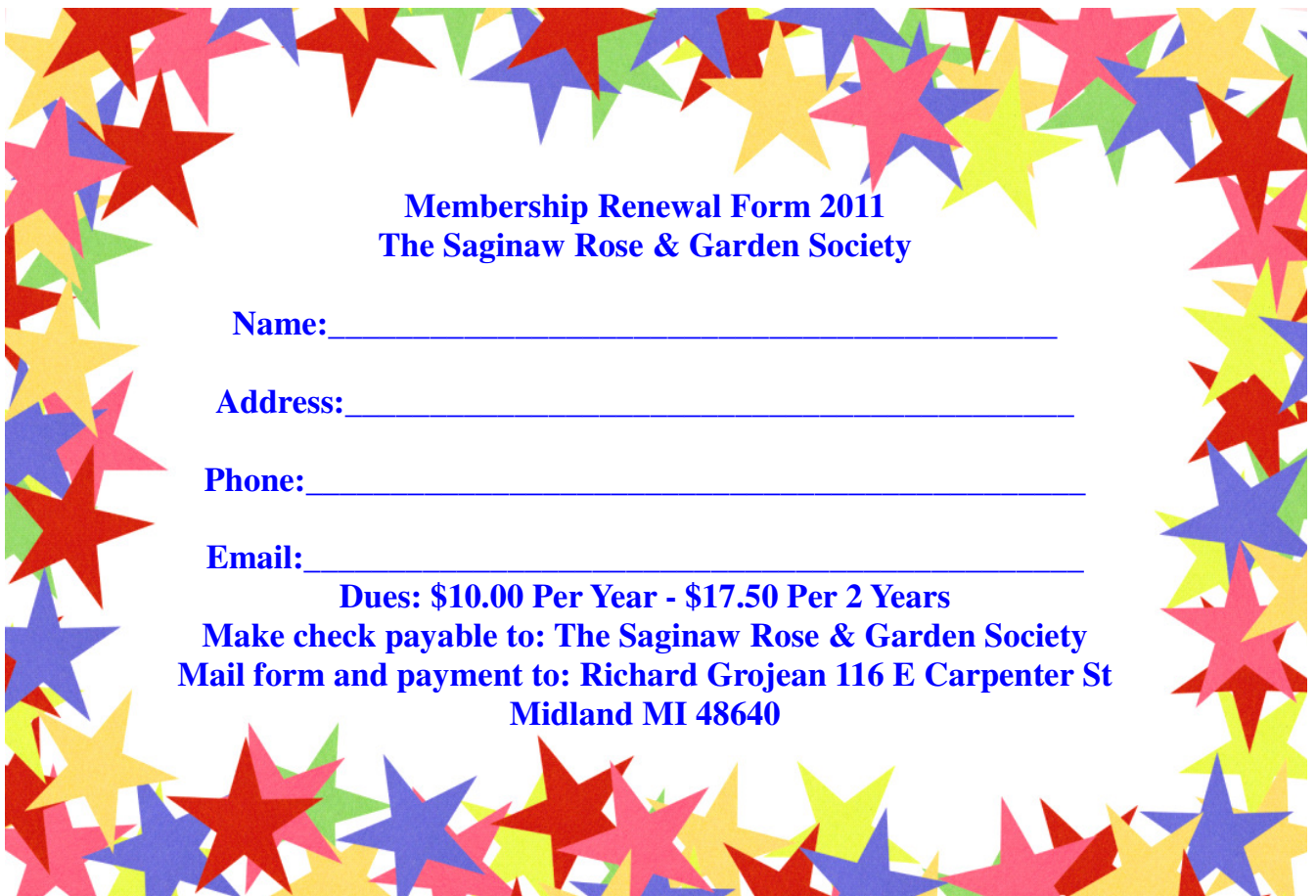

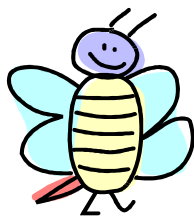

I call this season(WRAP IT UP) Meaning, of course garden tasks(not Christmas gifts)

If you use rose cones, then you will be cutting pretty far back soon. As you do take note of canes that contain borers. If left they will eat down to the bud joint by spring. and possibly destroy the plant. I have a big problem with borers maybe you do not.

Do not make ideal mouse houses to let for winter. The mama will not pay the rent and will eat all the bark to feed the young. Wrapping a climbing rose in burlap is fine to protect from winter winds, as long as you do not have a mouse about. Then that is a good thing. Depending on the type of leaves you have, they could be used as a protection. Just do not use , like silver maples as they pack down and become soggy messes. Drier leaves like oak are fine. SEE
